Competition Area	The competitions will take place in the southwestern part of Denmark. More specific close to Oksbøl barracks, situated 25 km northwest of Esbjerg.
Terrain and maps	All competitions will be held in Vrøgum forest.
Classes	Individual competitions: M21, M35, M45, M55, M65, W21, W35, M21B, W21B, M-20B and W-20B. B means easier and shorter orienteering course, but the same shooting and location orienteering as the other classes. Relay: M21 (3 legs), W21 (2 legs), M40/W40 (3 legs), Open/Mix class (3 legs but maximum one M21 runner)
Course length	Sprint: Estimated winning time in all classes (including shooting time) is 25 min. Classic: Location orienteering approx. 3 km. Estimated best total running time (without penalties): M21 100 min, other classes 80 min. Relay: Estimated winning time per leg in all classes (including shooting time) is 40 min.
Punching system	EMIT system will be used, please state number in the entry form. EMIT card can be rented at a fee of DKK 10 per competition/day. If an EMIT card number is not specified at entry form, a rental card will be allocated. Competitors failing to return rented EMIT card will be charged a fee of DKK 400.
Entry	Only for competitors/clubs outside Denmark (Danish competitors make entry through their clubs directly to DMI, according to the Danish invitation). Entry form must be received for each club not later than Wednesday 4 April by email to kaja@stofanet.dk (Jan Møller) Please use the entry form for all competitions and accommodation/dinner.

Accommodation	Accommodation will be possible at the military barracks in Oksbøl, but only in large rooms. Accommodation includes bedlinen (sheets and towels). Please use the entry form.	
Dinner	An unofficial dinner will take place Wednesday evening at the barracks, starting 18.30. The price will be DKK 150. Please use the entry form.	
Weapon	Competitors bring their own weapon and ammunition.	
Fees	DKK 100 per entry/competition. Accommodation DKK 50 per night. Foreign participants pay their fees to Jan Møller, at the first day of the competitions in DKK.
