Regarding both sprint and classic, in M/W16 there are no lower age restrictions though the responsibility lies entirely on the competitor/his/hers club and parents. Only prone shooting and the same location orienteering as all other classes.

All teams consist of two participants except M21-teams which consists of three.

Master-teams: Total age of team participants, all participants must be born 1982 or earlier.


