WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP BIATHLON ORIENTEERING 2010 (WCBO-2010)

September 16th – 19th, Nymindegab, Denmark

General.

Danish Military Sports Association and Kolding Orienteering Club arrange the World Championship in Biathlon Orienteering 2010 (WCBO-2010) in Denmark. More information is given at <http://www.biathlon.dk/wc>.

This invitation is sent to national associations and is present at the webpage. Be sure to register and pay according to formulas (entry fee and accommodation) in due time. Final date for registration is August 25th 2010.

Thursday, September 16th: (Arrival-Training in Nymindegab)

- Arrival and registration from 1000 hours.
- Training 1300 – 1700. (Shooting and orienteering)
- Official opening of the championship 1900.
- Preliminary meeting 1930. (Instruction etc.)

Friday, September 17th: (Sprint in Nymindegab)

- Adjustment shooting 1000 – 1130.
- Sprint competition 1300 – 1600.
- Competition meeting 1900. (Sprint and Classic)

Saturday, September 18th: (Classic in Frederikshaab)

- Adjustment shooting 0830-0930.
- Classic competition 1000 – 1600.
- Competition meeting 1730 (Classic and Relay)
- Enlarged IBOF meeting 1800.
- Banquet and prize ceremony 1900.

Sunday, September 19th: (Relay in Frederikshaab – departure)

- Adjustment shooting 0830-0930.
- Relay competition 1000-1300.
- Prize giving 1330.
- Departure from 1400.

Categories.

Following classes are defined:

- World Championships (sprint, classic and relay): M21 and W21.
- World Championships, Juniors (sprint, classic and relay): M20 and W20.
- World Championships, Veterans (sprint, classic and relay): M35, M40, M45, M50, M55, M60 and W35, W40, W45, W50, W55, W60.
- Introduction 1: (sprint and classic): Medium difficult orienteering, prone and standing shooting, standing targets.
- Introduction 2: (sprint and classic): Medium difficult orienteering, only prone shooting, standing targets.
- Mix class, relay: Open competition for women and men. No restriction on age.

As these championships also count to the World Cup, there will be no restrictions on numbers of participants from each country in classes M21 and W21.

In World Championships, relay competition M-21 team consists of three competitors. In all other classes relay teams consist of only two competitors.

After registration by August 25th 2010 the organizer holds the right to combine classes in individual as well as relay competitions having less than three competitors/teams. Any such combination will be announced at the webpage before the competition.

Courses.

- Sprint: Orienteering – prone shooting – orienteering – standing shooting.
- Classic: Location orienteering – normal orienteering – prone shooting – standing shooting.
- Relay: Orienteering – prone shooting – orienteering – standing shooting. (2 or 3 on each team depending on the category)

Regulations.

Championships are arranged strictly to the IBOF rules. Please find details and link to the rules at the web site.

Terrain and Maps.

- Nymindégab: Gødel Bjerge 1:10.000. Contour interval 2.5 metres. New map from 2009, adjusted in 2010.
- Frederikshaab: Frederikshåb 1:10.000. Contour interval 2.5 metres. New map from 2009, adjusted in 2010.

Control System.

EMIT-system will be used. Please give your EMIT-number by registration or ask for rent of EMIT (15 DKR pr. day). To be paid together with entry fee etc.

Weapon and Ammunition.

Only Calibre 5.6 mm (.22 LR) rifles are used. Weapon and ammunition must be brought by all participants. Before each competition a weapons control should be expected.

Entry Fees.

Sprint, Classic and Relay: 110 DKR per class, per person.

Last date for registering and paying the entry etc. is August 25th 2010.

Accommodation.

Accommodation during the competition period is at own responsibility and cost.

The organizer arranges accommodation in military barracks in Nymindegab Barracks. (Unfortunately the possibility of having two-beds room is already overbooked in the given period.)

You may request accommodation in 10-beds room (45 DKR per person per night) and meals:

Breakfast: 35 DKR.

Lunch (Thursday and Friday): 65 DKR.

Lunch packet (Saturday and Sunday): 50 DKR.

Dinner (Thursday and Friday): 65 DKR.

Banquet, Saturday evening: 150 DKR.

To be requested and paid by registration with entry fee etc.
